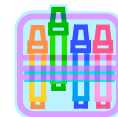

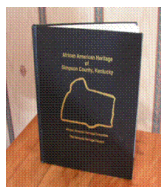

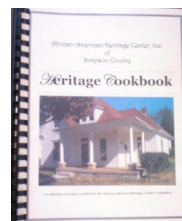

DECEMBER FEATURED RECIPE:(page 201)

"Spinach Lasagna Recipe" By: Effie Willis

- 1 pkg(16 oz) Lasagna Noodles
- 10 oz pkg frozen spinach, thawed & squeezed dry
- 1 lb. ricotta cheese
- 1 1/2 jars (26oz each) spaghetti sauce (4 1/2 cup divided)
- 1/2 lb mozzarella cheese shredded (about 2 cups)
- 3 Tbsp grated parmesan cheese



Preheat oven to 375 . Coat 9 x 13 dish with nonstick cooking spray. Cook lasagna noodles according to pkg. directions; drain and set aside on wax paper. Combine ricotta, mozzarella and spinach. Add salt and pepper to taste, if desired. In bottom of baking dish, spread scant 1 c. tomato sauce. Top with 4 noodles, edges overlapping slightly. Spread 1/3 of cheese mixture over noodles. Top with scant 1 c. tomato sauce, 4 noodles and 1/3 of cheese mixture. Continue layering with remaining sauce, noodles, and cheese mixture, ending with noodles topped with tomato sauce. Sprinkle with top browns, about 5 minutes. Let stand 10 minutes before cutting.
